Topic: And God Said Part II

Text: Matthew 4:4-11

INTRODUCTION: God's word is like a constitution in the spiritual realm. Spiritual matters are not established by just arguments but by the word. John 10:35b. How do you then establish your case before God and before the devil if you are bankrupt of the word? In fact there are about 282 verses in the KJV and NKJV of the bible where you come across the word written. Jesus and the disciples were so good at the use of the word and this often kept His critics quiet. In John 10: 33-34, He kept His critics quite when He established to them that the scripture actually called them gods and so Him using God for Himself was not outside the purview of the word of God.

2. Love it. Psalms 1:2, 119:16, 35, 47-48, 97, 127, 131.

You should be qualified and certified to use it. John 3:3, II Pet 3:14-16, John 6:63, Rom 1:16-18, 8:6, I Cor 2:14, Heb. 11:3.

Why? Heb. 4:12, Jer. 23:29, John 4:15.
