Bible Study: Thursday June 17th 2014. **Topic: Rapture.**

TEXT: Luke 17:26-36

INTRODUCTION: The word rapture is one of those words which you will not find in the Bible. It was coined from certain words in the Bible. The Rapture (in Greek harpazo, in Latin rapio or rapturo) means "to seize upon by force", taken away suddenly or to snatch by force. This was interpreted from the words of Apostle Paul in I Thess 4: 13-17. The rapture refers to the sudden removal of all of God's people on the earth. In the twinkling of an eye, born again Christians will suddenly be transformed out of our human bodies and will rise up into the air to join Jesus Christ.

Interestingly the doctrine of the rapture has also torn believers apart for years and it is still doing it today. The uniting part of this division however is that the Jesus is going to come and that He is going to come for a church without spot or wrinkles. If we know this why should we bother ourselves so much about the period when He is going to come? If you are a wise person then you should be focused on getting prepared for Him since no one argues about His coming but about the time of his coming.

Today however we are going to take some time out to study a few points about the rapture.

To save the believers from the scourge of the anti Christ. - Rev 3: 10, Matthew 24: 21

To be with the Lord – I Thess 4:16-18.

To give room for the anti Christ to be revealed. II Thess 2:1-8

How - I Cor 15: 51-58

The mid tribulation group
The post Tribulation group

Who will go with Jesus during the rapture? I Thess 4:15-16, Rev 3: 10 Eph 5: 27. What are the signs when the rapture will occur? Matthew 24: 3-14, 2 Tim 3: 1-5, 7, I Tim 4: 1-3. What will be the state of the earth after the rapture? II Thess 2: 3, 6-7.
