The Power of Positive Speech.

- 1. Speak good things: II Chron 10:7, Prov 15:1, 23, Prov 12:18, Prov 16:24
- 2. Know when to speak: Ecc 8:5-6, Prov 25:11, Ecc 8:5, Isaiah 50:4, `Ecc 3:7, Prov 10:32,
- 3. Speak words that encourage: Gen 50:21, Isaiah 35:4, Col 4;6. Eph 4:29, Prov 15:4, Isaiah 50:4, Job 4:4,
- 4. Use of words in a relationship. Prov 31:26, Gen 16:3-4, Prov 25:11, Prov 16:24
- 5. Good words preserve: Prov 14:3,
- 6. To avoid talking evil about others always think of the good sides of people.
- If you want to have good friends, learn to keep secrets. Prov 11:13,
- 8. Been quiet could take practice: Job 6:24a, I Thess 4:11
